

Their Eyes Were Watching God Poster

We will be using a tracking poster to follow a single motif or symbol throughout the novel.

Your poster will consist of a thematic thesis statement regarding the motif or symbol you have chosen surrounded by evidence of that motif or symbol in the book and visual representations of it.

- 1) Place the thesis as well as a related image in the center of the poster or at the top.
- 2) Then, trace the motif or symbol through the novel, selecting the most important examples. Place correctly documented quotations with commentary (under or next to each quotation), and possibly some illustrations, around the central motif or symbol and thesis statement. Ideally, these are placed in textual order in order to guide the viewer through and around your poster.
- 3) Finally, add a conclusion of one or two sentences on the poster.
